Mrs. Louise Elizabeth Jones Tracy of Forrest City, Arkansas, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Wednesday, November 16, 2016. She was born in St. Louis, Missouri to Charles and Stella Lincoln Jones on September 2, 1924. She was preceded in death by her husband of over sixty years Aubrey E. Tracy in 2003. Because of her husband's failing health and his need for a warmer climate, in 1976, Mrs. Tracy retired from Chicago Rawhide, Elgin, Illinois, where she had served as Production Office Supervisor for many years and returned to Forrest City. She devoted her life to caring for her husband and others and serving her Lord. She loved her family without measure and nothing gave her greater joy than cooking for them.

Mrs. Tracy graduated from high school in Forrest City, Ar., being the last member of her class to pass away.
