Mary Elizabeth Burrows Jones, of Forrest City, entered her heavenly home on March 31, 2021 where she joined her father, Fay A. Burrows, mother, Evelyn Burrows Dunn, brother, Steven Burrows, and sister-in-law, Peggy Hosman Burrows. Beth was born in Fayetteville on May 9, 1947 and lived most of her life in Forrest City, Arkansas. She graduated Forrest City High School, Southern Baptist College in Walnut Ridge (now Williams Baptist University) where she was secretary to President Dr. H.E. Williams, and Henderson State University in Arkadelphia. She retired from Forrest City Public Schools where she ran the computer lab at Central Elementary. During her career she also taught briefly in Northwest Arkansas, Oklahoma, and Colorado.

Beth loved the Lord and was a member of First Baptist Church in Forrest City where she was very active. She sang in the choir and ladies ensemble and played the piano. She also taught Sunday School and Vacation Bible School for many years, was heavily involved with the "clothes closet ministry", and headed up the annual Operation Christmas Child drive. Beth was also active and had served as president of the Forrest City Musical Coterie. One of Beth's great passions was her quilting where she was in great demand throughout the area and loved working with the ladies at First Baptist in their quilting ministry, Caring Touch. Beth was a gentle and loving person who was loved by all who knew her and will be greatly missed.

Having no children of her own, "Aunt Beth" (aka Uncle Beffuss) loved and was loved by her "adopted kids"-her many nephews, nieces, grand nephews and

nieces, for whom she made special decorated cakes and quilts for each.
