Mrs. Mary Fleming Quinn, age 93, of Forrest City, died Tuesday at the Crossridge Community Hospital in Wynne. She had been in the hospital for the past two weeks.

Mrs. Quinn was born June 17, 1919, in Big Creek, Mississippi, and was the daughter of Luther C. Wooten and Ola Carter Wooten. She lived in St. Francis County most of her life, was a secretary/bookkeeper for Goodyear, and was a member of the First Baptist Church in Forrest City.

Mrs. Quinn married J. Allen Fleming in 1944, and he preceded her in death in 1978. She married Murrell Quinn in 1982, and he survives her along with two daughters; Betty Higgins of Forrest City and Helen Ponder McWilliams of Jonesboro, four grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild. She had one grandson, James Daryl Ponder who preceded her in death in 2001.
