Rev. Milton Lowry Wilson, 82 of Hampton, AR, went to be with His Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on Tuesday, January 10, 2023. He was born on March 18, 1940 at Payneway, AR to the late James Earl Wilson and Ernestine Dillahunt.

He was a 1958 graduate of Forrest City High School and attended Ouachita Baptist University. On November 4, 1962, he married Alice L. West.
