Mrs. Clark was an active member of the Bethel Baptist Church in Forrest City, Arkansas and lived in Caldwell, Arkansas since 1963 until becoming a resident of the Ashton Place, formerly Heartland, Rehabilitation and Nursing Care Center in Memphis, Tennessee, in December 2003.
