



## Nadine Jones

August 17, 1935 - May 9, 2021

Mrs. Nadine Jones, age 85, of Goodwin, died Sunday, May 9, 2021, at her home in Goodwin. She had been in poor health for the past year.

Mrs. Jones was born August 17, 1935, in Greenfield, Arkansas, and was the daughter of Rudy Butts and Sessil Edwards Butts. She lived in Goodwin most of her life, became postmaster for the Goodwin Post Office in 1956, and retired in 1991. She loved to paint and to travel with her family and friends and was a member of the Wheatley United Methodist Church.

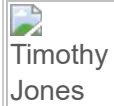
