Mr. Noal D. Russell, age 74, of Caldwell, died Sunday at the Flo & Phil Jones Hospice House in Jonesboro.

Mr. Russell was born March 8, 1942, in Poughkeepsie, Arkansas, and was the son of Lavoyd Russell and Donald Denton Russell. He lived in Forrest City most of his life, was retired from Woodruff Electric, was a member of the Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite, and was a member of the Landmark Missionary Baptist Church, where he served as Deacon and past Sunday School Superintendent.
