Mr. Pat McNamee, age 87, of Forrest City, died Sunday at the Forrest City Medical Center in Forrest City. He had been in the hospital for the past two days.

Mr. McNamee was born August 28, 1927, in Water Valley, Mississippi, and was the son of George Patrick McNamee and Lou Cosby McNamee. He lived in Forrest City most of his life, was a retired manager of the meat market at Kroger in Forrest City after forty-two years of service, and was a member of the First Baptist Church.

Mr. McNamee married Mary Hale in 1949, and she survives him along with one daughter, Judy Belcher, and husband, Terry, of Walnut Ridge, Arkansas, one sister, Sue Brasel of Itta Bena, Mississippi, four grandchildren; Gwen, Mary Lynn, Jason, and Ryan. He had one son, William Patrick 'Bill' McNamee, who preceded him in death in 2013.
