



Ralph Edward Beazley

Ralph Edward Beazley, age 78, of Forrest City, died Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at his home in Forrest City. He had been in poor health for the past three years.

Mr. Beazley was born October 26, 1946, in Memphis, Tennessee, and was the son of James Walton Beazley II and Ruth Surginer Beazley. He lived in Forrest City all of his life, was a graduate of Forrest City High School and Arkansas State University. He was a licensed operator and served forty years with the Forrest City Water Utility. He was a member of the Arkansas Waterworks and Water Environment Association and attended the First Baptist Church in Forrest City.

Mr. Beazley married Gretchen Roller in 1982, and she survives him along with one brother, Jim Beazley III, and wife, Gracie, of Palestine, three nieces, Melanie, Beth, and Jamie, one nephew, Walt, one step-son, Perry George, and one step-daughter, Noel McCutchen. He was preceded in death by one step-son, Taylor George, in 2017.
