



## Ray 'Jake' Thweatt

March 7, 1926 - November 3, 2018

Mr. Ray 'Jake' Thweatt, age 92, of Palestine, died Saturday, November 3, 2018, at the Baptist Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee. He had been in the hospital for the past ten days.
