



## Rebecca Kaye 'Becky' Houston

September 10, 1959 - August 4, 2022

Rebecca Kaye 'Becky' Houston, age 62, of Forrest City, died Thursday, August 4, 2022, at her home in Forrest City. She had been in poor health for the past several years.
