



Richard Justin Withrow

October 7, 1981 - June 21, 2025

Richard Justin Withrow, age 43, of Wynne, died Saturday, June 21, 2025, at his home. His death came sudden and unexpected. Mr. Withrow was born October 7, 1981 in Memphis, Tennessee and was the son of Richard Withrow and Karen Ferguson Withrow. He was a member of the Graham Memorial Presbyterian Church and was a veteran of the US Coast Guard. Growing up in Forrest City, Arkansas, Justin found a sport that he took seriously and developed to the best of his ability. Under the direction of Astin Taekwondo, he received his 2nd Degree Black Belt in Taekwondo. In the 9th grade, he made the decision to further his education by attending Saint Andrews Episcopal College Preparatory School, graduating in 2000. He attended Centenary College of Louisiana, where he pledged Kappa Sigma Fraternity. In 2004 he joined the United States Coast Guard stationed in Astoria, Oregon. After the Coast Guard, he moved to Newport, Rhode Island where he established "JW Marine Detailing." After years in Rhode Island, he moved to Sarasota, Florida and continued detailing at the local marinas. Leaving Florida, he moved closer to home and lived in Searcy, Arkansas and Little Rock, Arkansas before moving to Wynne. Finally, at the last year of his life, he fulfilled his dream of working as an IT web developer and started his own business, "Studio Mark Digital." Mr. Withrow is survived by his parents, Richard and Karen Withrow, of Forrest City; and one aunt, Dee Withrow Ptak, of Hurst, Texas. He is preceded in death by his grandparents, Lynn and Joe Ferguson, and Louise and Damon Withrow. Graveside services will be held Friday, June 27, 2025 at 11:00 a.m.

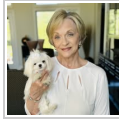
“ Richard and Karen,
