



## Mr. Robert "Bob" Sohn

December 2, 1930 - July 26, 2014

Mr. Robert "Bob" Sohn age 83 of Forrest City, Arkansas died Saturday, July 26, 2014 at the River Ridge Nursing Home in Wynne.

Mr. Sohn was born December 2, 1930 in Carlyle, Illinois. He was the son of Frank Sohn and Veronica Dittmer Sohn. Mr. Sohn was a industrial engineer graduating from Milwaukee School of Engineering and had worked for I.T.T. in Milan, Tennessee and Sanyo Manufacturing Company in Forrest City. He served in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict. Mr. Sohn was a member of the Graham Memorial Presbyterian Church in Forrest City where he was a member of the Men of the Church, Elder and Sunday School Teacher. In later years he was a commissioned Lay Pastor serving churches in Des Arc and Brinkley, Arkansas. He had also served as a Cub Scout Master and Boy Scout leader in Milan, Tennessee.

Mr. Sohn married Gertrude "Trudy" Sohn in 1958. She survives him along with a daughter Carolyn Sohn of Fayetteville, Arkansas; a son David Sohn of Forrest City and three grandchildren Jacob, Carly and Jenna Sohn all of Marianna, Arkansas. Mr. Sohn was preceded in death by his parents and infant son Michael Robert Sohn and two brothers Roy and Ralph Sohn.
