Mr. Rodger Dean Taylor, age 59, of Searcy, formerly of Forrest City, died Friday at his home in Searcy. He had been in poor health for the past several months.

Mr. Taylor was born July 13, 1952, in Forrest City, and was the son of J. C. Taylor and Mary Brown Taylor. He lived in Forrest City and moved to Searcy in 1994, was an engineer for the U. P. Railroad, and was a Baptist.
