December 28, 1920 - November 30, 2008

Mr. Roger R. Reynolds age 87, of Forrest City, Arkansas died Sunday, November 30, 2008 at the Forrest City Medical Center.

Mr. Reynolds was born December 18, 1920 in Hawthorne, New York. He was the son of Robert E. Reynolds and Helen DeForest Reynolds. Mr. Reynolds graduated from New York University, Midshipman School at Columbia University and Annapolis, after which he was assigned to a destroyer in the Pacific Fleet as a Communications Officer. His career with Yale & Towne Manufacturing Company took him to New York City, Boston, Houston and Forrest City where he was marketing manager for Yale Hoists for the U.S. and Canada.

Mr. Reynolds was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Forrest City for 36 years, and took great joy as a member of the Hammons Foundation to provide college scholarships for area young people and served on the Forrest City Water Board.

Mr. Reynolds married Muriel A. Hamilton in 1946. She survives him along with a son Rick Reynolds and wife Helen of Cordova, Tennessee; a daughter, Marilyn Fields and husband Ken of Pryor, Oklahoma. He is also survived by 4 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren.

Services will be held Thursday, December 4, 2008 at 2:00 p.m. at the First Baptist Church in Forrest City. Burial will follow at Forrest Park Cemetery.
