Mr. Roy W. Ford, age 67, of West Memphis, died Thursday at the Baptist Hospital in Memphis. He had been in the hospital for the past three weeks.

Mr. Ford was born September 12, 1940, in Palestine, and was the son of J. C. Ford Sr. and Lena Dover Ford. He lived in Forrest City most of his life and was a past employee of the Forrest City Times Herald and Yale Industries.
