



Ruby Rice Cook

July 2, 1927 - January 26, 2011

Mrs. Ruby Jeanette Rice Cook, age 83, of Forrest City, died Wednesday at the Forrest City Medical Center in Forrest City. Her death came suddenly and unexpectedly.

Mrs. Cook was born July 2, 1927, in Gilmore, Arkansas, and was the daughter of Reed Meadows Rice and Addie Lou Franks Rice. She lived in Forrest City most of her life, was a retired Secretary and Bookkeeper from the Transportation Department with the Forrest City Public Schools, was a charter member of the St. Francis Rural Water Association, and was a member of the Madison Methodist Church.

Mrs. Cook married Grady Douglas Cook in 1945, and he preceded her in death in 1999.
