



## Ruby Evelyn Tyer

July 30, 1929 - December 17, 2017

Mrs. Ruby Evelyn Tyer, age 88, of Forrest City, died Sunday at the Crestpark Retirement Inn in Forrest City. She had been in poor health for the past six weeks.

Mrs. Tyer was born July 30, 1929, in Henning, Tennessee, and was the daughter of Jack Williams and Flossie Conder Williams. She lived in St. Francis County most of her life, was a beautician, a clerk for the Forrest City Water Department and a teacher's aid in the reading program for the Forrest City Middle School.
