



## Samuel Ledal 'Pop' Armstrong

January 10, 1944 - July 27, 2022

Samuel Ledal 'Pop' Armstrong, age 78, of Forrest City, died Wednesday, July 27, 2022, at the Methodist University Hospital in Memphis. He had been in poor health for the past six weeks.

Mr. Armstrong was born January 10, 1944, in Osceola, Arkansas, and was the son of Elmer Wally and Opal Lee Armstrong. He moved to Forrest City in 1971, worked for the Forrest City Water Utility Department, was an electrical and plumbing inspector, was on the board of the Newcastle Volunteer Fire Department, was an inspector for the Palestine Sewer System, and was a salesman for water work supplies for several companies. He graduated from Earle High School where he also played for the Earle Bulldogs. He served on the St. Francis County Quorum Court for several years and was a member of the Good Hope Baptist Church.

He loved people and would help anyone he could. He never met a stranger.

Mr. Armstrong married Judith 'Judy' L. Jackson in 1968, and she survives him along with one son, Anthony Dewayne Armstrong, and wife, Carmen, of Forrest City, one sister, Carolyn Ruth Armstrong of Forrest City, three grandchildren; Sarajane Elizabeth, Marylynn Michelle, and Anthony 'D.J.' Dewayne Jr., two brother's-in-law; Michael Jackson and Timothy Jackson of Forrest City, and several nieces and nephews and a host of friends. He had

two brothers; Edward Armstrong, Gary Armstrong, three half brothers; Harry Armstrong, Charlie Armstrong and Ease Armstrong, one half sister, Maxie Greenhaw, who all preceded him in death.

Services for Mr. Armstrong will be held Graveside, 11:00 A.M., Saturday, at the Forrest Park Cemetery in Forrest City.
