Mr. Samuel David Wilson, age 87, of Forrest City, died Wednesday at his home in Forrest City. He had been in poor health for the past year.

Mr. Wilson was born June 24, 1922 in Trumann, Arkansas, and was the son of Willie Norbin Wilson and Laura Etta Blackman Wilson.
