



Thomas Theodore Bridges

August 2, 1934 - May 4, 2018

Thomas Theodore Bridges, formerly of Forrest City, passed away at his home in Wynne, Friday, May 4, 2018, after a lengthy illness. He was 83 years old.

Mr. Bridges was born to Theodore Hicks Bridges and Helen Samantha Nicholas on August 2, 1934, in Vandale. For most of his life he resided in the Forrest City area. While in Forrest City he worked with the Forrest City Police Department, Arkansas Highway Department and retired with twenty-seven years of service from the Forrest City School District. A lifelong proponent of sports and athletics, he was inducted into the Arkansas Referee Hall of Fame and the Forrest City Mustang Hall of Fame.

Mr. Bridges is survived by his wife of fifty-six years, Katherine Marie Snider, three daughters; Linda Speer of Wynne, Deb Joyner of Granbury, Texas, and Tommie Howie of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, one son, Charles Bridges of Judsonia, five grandchildren, and nine great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Annette Coats, of Colt, Arkansas.

Services for Mr. Bridges will be held at Stevens Funeral Home Chapel, 2:00 P.M., Monday, with burial in Forrest Park Cemetery. Visitation will be Monday, 1:00 P.M., until the time of the service.
