



Thomas 'Dow' Callahan

March 15, 1921 - October 11, 2016

Mr. Thomas 'Dow' Callahan, age 95, of Little Rock, formerly of Tuni, died Tuesday at the Veteran's Hospital in Little Rock. He had been in poor health for the past two weeks.

Mr. Callahan was born March 15, 1921, in Madison, and was the son of James Franklin Callahan and Myrtle Mikles Callahan Brown. He lived in St. Francis County most all of his life, was a Veteran of World War II, and a farmer.

Mr. Callahan married Gearldine Collie in 1939, and she preceded him in death in 2008.
