



## Tom Floyd

June 23, 1928 - August 29, 2012

Mr. Tom Joe Floyd age 84, of Forrest City, Arkansas died at the Crittenden Memorial Hospital in West Memphis, on Wednesday, August 29, 2012.

Mr. Floyd was born June 23, 1928 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was the son of Joe Henry Floyd and Muriel Janice Ross Floyd.
