April 27, 1941 - December 14, 2022

Tommy Poindexter, age 81, currently of Cave City, Arkansas, and a former long time resident of Forrest City, Arkansas, passed away Wednesday, December 14, 2022, at the St. Bernard's Medical Center in Jonesboro.

Tommy was born April 27, 1941, in Marked Tree, Arkansas, and was the son of Joe and Pat Poindexter. He retired in June 2001 as a manufacturing engineer after forty-two years with Yale Hoists. He enjoyed being a ham radio operator and traveling, especially camping. He and his wife, Linda, retired the same day and enjoyed traveling during their retirement, their most recent trip being this September to the Big Horn Mountains and Yellowstone in Wyoming. He and Linda were able to visit thirty-nine states in their many years of traveling adventures.

Tommy was a member of the First Missionary Baptist Church, Cave City, Arkansas. Prior to moving to Cave City in 2021, Tommy faithfully served at the Landmark Missionary Baptist Church in Forrest City for forty-eight years. He served as the Secretary/Treasurer for the St. Francis Rural Water Association for a number of years and was also an active member of the Crowley's Ridge Amateur Radio Club.

He is survived by his wife of forty-eight years, Linda (Williford) Poindexter along with daughter, Tommie Carol Neeley, and husband, Jeff, of Cave City,
