Mr. Vester P. Wroten, age 91, of West Memphis, formerly of Forrest City, died Friday at the Broadway Health Care in West Memphis. He had been in poor health for the past two years.

Mr. Wroten was born September 18, 1920, in Booneville, Mississippi, and was the son of Kelley Allen Wroten and Girtie Bell Paden Wroten. He retired as service manager for Eldridge Chevrolet, was a Veteran of World War II, was retired from the National Guard, was a Lieutenant Colonel of the Civil Air Patrol, and was a Protestant.

Mr. Wroten married Myrline Bryant in 1973, and she preceded him in death in 2001. He is survived by one son, Kelley Wroten of West Memphis, one daughter, Debra Hempel of Millington, Tennessee, two sisters; Edith Hughes of Corinth, Mississippi and Betty Baker of Florida, one step-son, David Morgan of Texas, one step-daughter, Mary Allen of California, two grandchildren, one great-grandchild, and a loving friend, Glenda Williams.
