Mr. Wayne L. Dillinger, age 88, of Palestine, died Saturday, June 1, 2019, at the Hospice Home Care in Little Rock. He had been in poor health for the past two years.

Mr. Dillinger was born August 19, 1930, in Greencastle, Indiana, and was the son of Cary Dillinger and Olive Johnson Dillinger.
